

Submitting Code Enforcement Complaints to the City of Spokane

1. What are Code Enforcement complaints?

Solid waste, junk vehicles, Fire hazard vegetation (during fire hazard season), Substandard/Abandoned Buildings, Right of way obstructions, including vegetation that obstructs the right of way or obstructs visibility at intersections, zoning violations (home occupations, prohibited uses, sign issues), parking violations (which would be handled by parking enforcement), and graffiti.

2. What are the ways in which a complaint can be submitted?

There are multiple ways. Complaint forms can be submitted on a form sent via email, mail, or fax to Code Enforcement. Complaints can be submitted over the phone by calling 311. Complaints also can be submitted online, using the online portal <https://aca.spokanepermits.org/CitizenAccess/default.aspx>
